Hotel Information:

Transportation Between Airport and Hotel:

Taxi: about \$35, about 15 to 20 minutes.

Take “Red line” to Tower City (Down town) station first, about 30 minutes, then, change to “Waterfront” line to “Flat East Bank” station, almost in front of the hotel, about 5 minutes.
